

Menomonie Farmers Market Rules and Regulations

1. All products being sold at the market must be grown or produced by the vendor within a 30-mile radius of Menomonie. The Market Manager reserves the right to include products outside of that radius if it is a Wisconsin product and inclusion of the product will enhance the market.
2. It is the responsibility of every vendor to know if they are required to collect and remit Wisconsin Sales Tax.
3. Vendors selling processed or "ready to eat" foods are responsible for obtaining all licenses and or permits required by the Dunn County Public Health Department and the State of Wisconsin. Copies of all licenses or permits must be on file with West CAP prior to selling at the Market.
4. The Market Manager and West CAP reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any vendor or item that is not in keeping with the rules or quality of the Market.
5. Craft items sold must be hand-crafted by the vendor. Absolutely no "kit" crafts are allowed.
6. Assignment of stalls: Vendors will be assigned stalls prior to the first market day based on returned applications and fees. Parking lot vendors are allowed one vehicle only per stall, as space permits no exceptions. No vehicle may extend beyond the given stall area. All other vehicles must be removed from the immediate Market premises.
7. Absolutely no vehicles are allowed on the park grass at any time. Two stalls will be reserved for loading and unloading.
8. Vendors must furnish their own tables, chairs, brooms, dustpans and garbage removal. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their stalls at the end of each Market Day; garbage must be removed from the Market.
9. Leftover produce may NOT be placed in the city trash bins. Talk to other vendors: they may be interested in using it for compost.
10. Vendors may not advertise that they have organic produce unless they have been certified organic. A copy of the certification must be on file with West CAP.
11. Respect other vendors and Menomonie Farmers Market customers. Profanity, yelling and / or heckling will not be tolerated.
12. Vendors may not sublet space. West CAP retains the right to approve and facilitate all arrangements pertaining to subletting space.
13. If a vendor is not in attendance for a period of two weeks without prior notice, the vending space will be considered open to other vendors.

West CAP Farmers Market Coordinator will enforce all rules and regulations. Disregard for any Market rules will cause action to be taken. West CAP retains the right to prohibit a vendor from participating in the Market, without a refund, if rules are broken.
